Dear Brothers and Sisters,

This weekend we celebrate the Feast of the Transfiguration. It falls each year on August 6, but August 6 only falls on a Sunday every six years or so, depending on the intervening leap years, so it has been a while since we celebrated it on a Sunday. It is a moment to think of the fact that Christ's divinity shone forth through his humanity for just a moment, foreshadowing the resurrection. It can remind us also as we go through our lives, which can often seem routine and mundane, that we too, are destined for glory, as the children of God that we are through our Baptism.

I would like to congratulate the four winners of our scholarships this year. We have the Fr. Maurice du Castillon scholarship (established in 1977) and the Fr. Leo Zonneveld scholarship (established in 2008). The scholarships are for Catholic students who are members of the parish and desire to pursue educational goals beyond high school.

The annual interest income from each fund is given in the form of a scholarship award to the recipients who demonstrate educational merit and financial need. The requirements for the recipient of the scholarship are: to be a practicing Catholic; an active member of Precious Blood parish; a high school graduate; to demonstrate both scholastic merit and a desire to continue education beyond high school; and to demonstrate financial need.

Congratulations to Caroline Dwyer for receiving the Fr. Leo Zonneveld scholarship of \$896.49 and to Arianna Agramonte for the Fr. Maurice du Castillon scholarship of \$806.71. The Knights of Columbus and the Ladies Auxiliary of the Knights of Columbus also offer their own scholarships and follow similar criteria. Congratulations to Sonya Laws for receiving the Knights of Columbus scholarship of \$500 and to Zachary Buttenshaw for the Ladies Auxiliary scholarship of \$500. We hope and pray that you will continue in your education and also grow in your faith in the coming years.
